1) Christians believe God has various qualities...

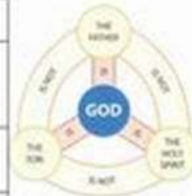
Omnipotent all powerful	They believe this because there is evidence in the Bible, for example: God parted the Red Sea, Created the world in 6 days.

2) Christians believe in one God...

Monotheism	The belief in one God
Trinity	The belief that God is one BUT can appear in 3 different ways God the father, Jesus the son and the Holy Spirit (3 in 1). An example of how this could be done: H2O can appear in 3 forms - ice, water, steam but it is still H2O
God the father	Jesus referred to God as 'Our father' in the Lord's prayer. The creator who has 3 key qualities - omnipotent, omniscient and omnibenevolent.
Jesus the son	God appears in human flesh - <b>incarnation</b> . Jesus was believed to be fully human and fully God
Holy Spirit	Believed to be the unseen power of God active in the world. Like the wind you can't see it but you see its effects. It has appeared in the Bible as a Dove - peace, Fire - purity and wind - power.



### Different Christian beliefs about Creation:

3) Christians believe God created the World as described in the book of Genesis but not all believe God did this in 6 days before resting.

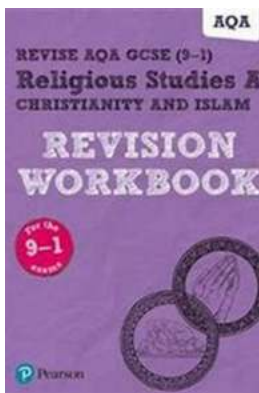
Creation	Some Christians believe God created the world in 6 days, made humans on the last day and rested on the 7 <sup>th</sup> . Everything was created good.
The Holy Spirit	Some Christians believe the Holy spirit hovered over the waters indicating it too was present from the beginning as part of God's nature.
The Word	John's gospel describes 'the word' being present from the beginning of time, meaning that God the Son or Jesus was present from the beginning.
