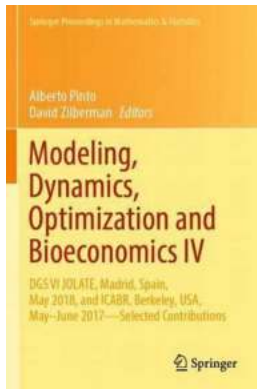

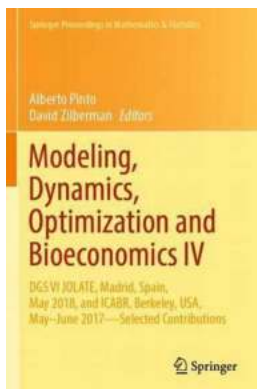
ICABR Berkeley USA May-June 2017
