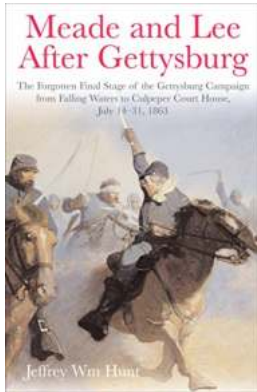
About the Author
