To date, human beings have only explored **5%** of Earth's oceans.

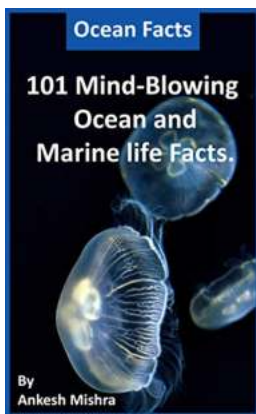
