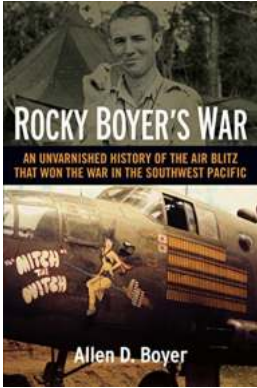

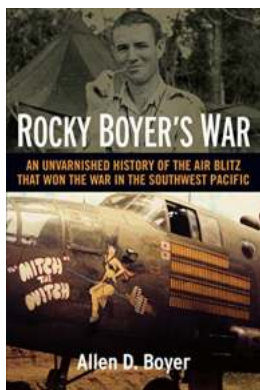

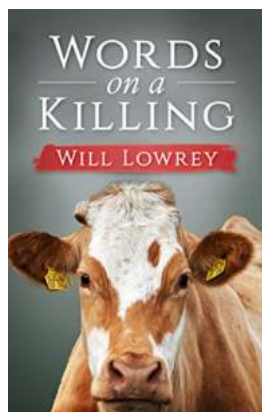

His group stepped in against Japanese counterstrikes, sharp, sudden fights against enemy warships.

- Off the island of Biak, in June 1944, the 17th Tactical Reconnaissance

Squadron, flying B-25's, attacked Japanese destroyers carrying enemy reinforcements. In 90 seconds, the squadron won 60 Distinguished Flying Crosses, 19 of them posthumous.

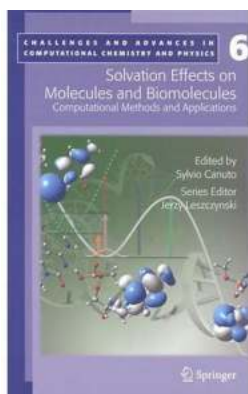
- On the beachhead at Mindoro, south of Manila in December 1944, Rocky fought in what Kenney called “the wildest scramble of the war”: a grim evening when the airfield was hit by Japanese bombers and shelled by a Japanese war fleet.
