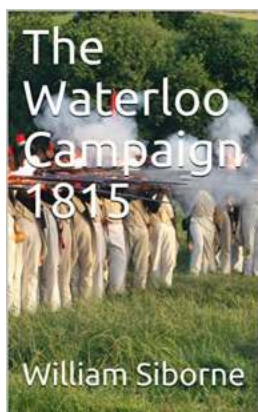

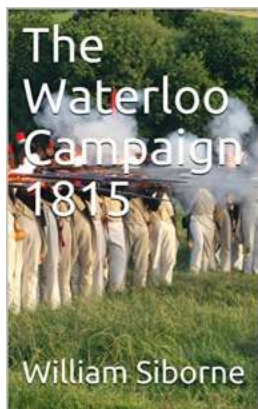

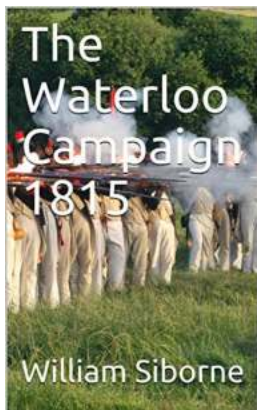

The reader must be good enough to observe that a Prussian Brigade then equalled in numbers a French or an English Division.

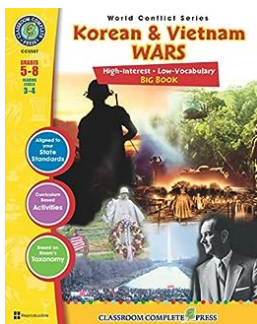
