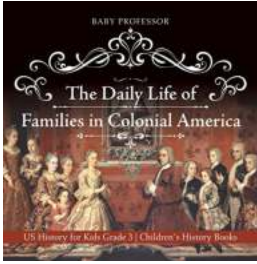
The Colonial Home
