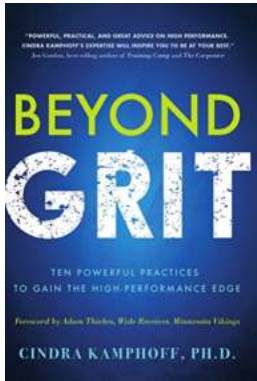

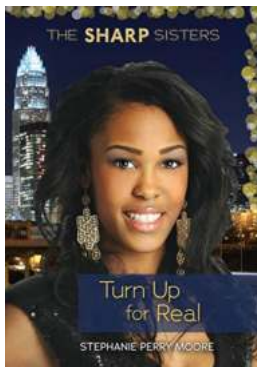
About the Illustrator
