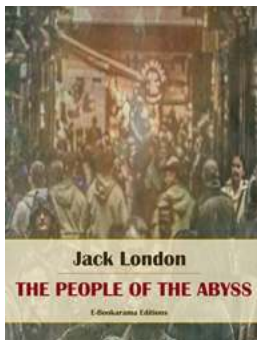

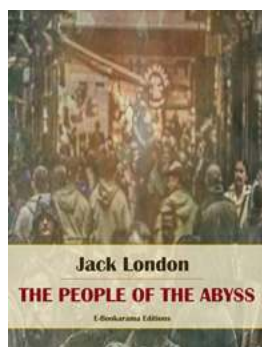

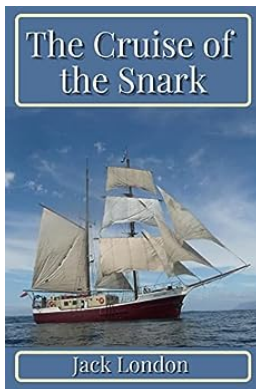


First published in 1903, "The People of the Abyss" tells Jack London's descent into London's east end in the 1900s.
