excited, and they convince her that her unseen bridegroom is truly a serpent who she must kill before he eats her.



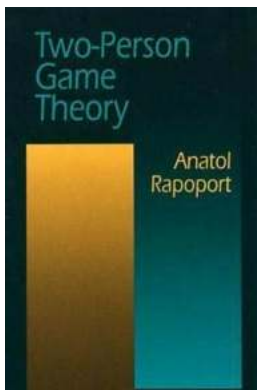
