





A work of this magnitude could not be published in a single book, so I have divided it into several collections, and the originals in Spanish are being translated into French, English and Portuguese.


The chronology goes from year to year, as far as possible, from prehistory to the present day.


The work is composed of two parts: first, it passes through the Geological eras, showing a map for each period, accompanying the continental masses movements, to the Holocene most familiar geographical contours.
