

# Thylacine: The Mysterious Creature That Fascinated Alan Heath

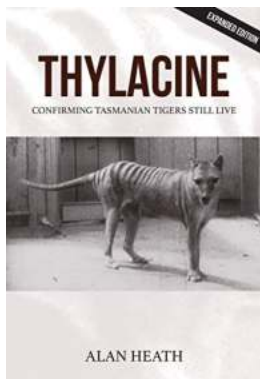

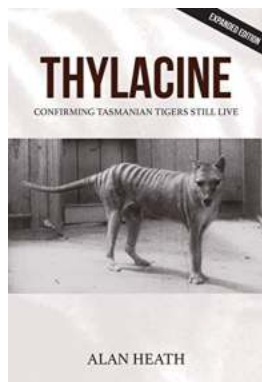

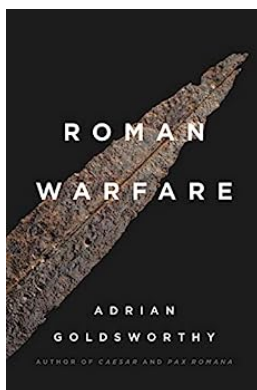

The author wrote this book at the suggestion of an academic working at a Queensland university, after the author told the academic about some of the Thylacine sightings that he had been told about in Queensland.



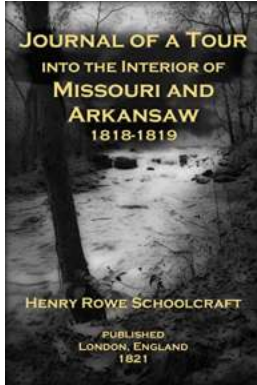
