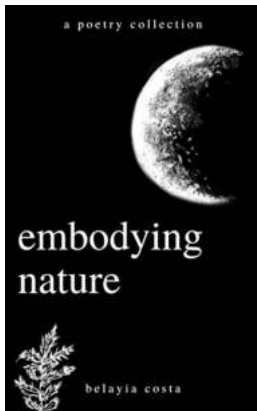

become call shy, but they never tire of attacking and killing coyotes, so the proper use of a coyote call can be the best way to bring in even educated wolves.



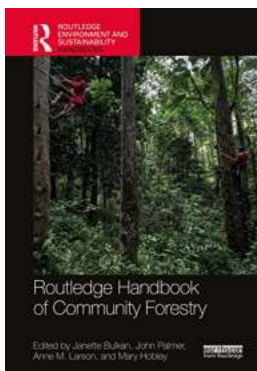
