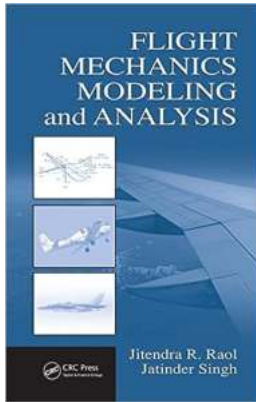


More coin hoards have been recorded from Roman Britain than from any other province of the Empire. A comprehensive online database (<https://finds.org.uk/database>) underpins the project, which also undertook a comprehensive GIS analysis of all the hoards and field surveys of a sample of them.



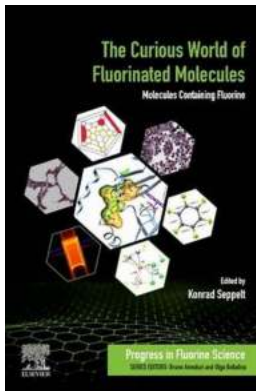
